As a lead contractor (we assume this is not possible due to the Member State registration requirement)?</li> <li>2. As a consortium member with an EU company as lead?</li> <li>3. As a subcontractor/Third Party to an EU lead contractor?</li> </ol>	<p>EIT Digital opened this call for proposal, that requests for services with a clear European background and interest, for organizations based in EU Member states. Therefor the RFP states the following in Section 8.4 of the RFQ: “the Tenderer must be registered in the professional and/or trade register kept in their Member State.”</p> <p>In case of a collaboration each individual party (both collaborators/consortium members as well as subcontractors) must individually sign and submit the declaration of honour and apply the requested extract from the trade register of their member state (RFP section 7.1). If the tenderer cannot comply with this and/or other requirements, it will be excluded.</p>

The University does not hold ISO 9001 certification, since ISO certifications are not granted at the institutional (university) level but are specific to individual processes or services.</p> <p>e) Not applicable. The University does not hold professional risk insurance, as Politecnico di Milano provides educational and research services and does not carry out professional activities requiring such insurance.</p> <p>Would this be acceptable for you?</p>	<p>The answer N/A is not correct.</p> <p>As stated in the RFP section 8.4 under 3, there is no reference/obligation to have a ISO 9001 or ISO certifications in general. A description of your qualitative management system is considered sufficient.</p> <p>With regard to occupational/professional risks and legal liability insurance please look at the description in the RFP section 8.4 under 2. This is considered a mandatory requirement. It does not necessarily need to be in place now, but it must be effective starting 1 November 2025.</p> <p>Please make sure to comply to the qualitative requirements. If you comply (or will be complying at the start) the correct answer on the DOH is Yes.</p>
