Why it matters: **The rebrand** marks full independence from the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) while keeping strong ties via a new Memorandum of Collaboration. With 23 offices in Europe and a global hub in Silicon Valley, 28DIGITAL is doubling down on its core pillars: **Talent. Tech. Trust.**

Behind the name: "28" nods to a new, borderless European innovation regime—and it's also a perfect number (just ask your local mathematician). Think cryptography, quantum computing, and next-gen algorithms.

Big picture: From launching thousands of deep tech ventures to educating tomorrow's digital leaders, the org formerly known as EIT Digital isn't slowing down. CEO Federico Menna calls the change "a declaration of intent" aligned with Europe's Startup and Scaleup Strategy—and designed to fuel a **competitive**,

human-centric, and sovereign digital future.

What's next: Expect sharp focus on green and strategic technologies, cross-border collaboration, and mission-driven innovation at scale.

28DIGITAL Enters Dubai Market at GITEX Global

In just 14 days since becoming 28DIGITAL, we've officially entered the Dubai market—signing two major MoUs with the Dubai Chamber of Digital Economy and the Dubai World Trade Centre during GITEX Global, the world's largest tech and startup event.

At Expand North Star, part of the GITEX ecosystem, we showcased seven stellar European startups and scaleups. Ariadne, Excalibur, IDloop®, Joii, Horsano, finQbit, and FULLVENUE brought deep tech, AI, and sustainability to the global stage—three even reached the Supernova Awards semi-finals. It's a bold start to a new chapter, focused on cross-continental collaboration, business growth, and tech diplomacy.

As CEO Federico Menna put it: "This marks the beginning of a new era in digital innovation for Europe, driven by global collaboration and shared ambition."



28DIGITAL Champions Winner Icometrix Heads to GE HealthCare

Big moves in brain tech: Belgian deep-tech pioneer **icometrix**—a 2020 winner of the 28DIGITAL Champions competition—has just signed an acquisition deal with **GE HealthCare**. The goal? Bring Al-powered neuroimaging to hospitals and research centers worldwide.

Why it matters: icometrix's **icobrain** platform uses AI to quantify brain lesions and atrophy from MRI and CT scans, offering critical insights for neurologists and radiologists. Now, with GE HealthCare's global reach and regulatory muscle, these tools are poised to scale—bringing greater precision, speed, and equity to neuro care.

The backstory: Spun out of the University of Antwerp and KU Leuven in 2011, icometrix turned heads during the pandemic by launching **Icolung**, a free chest-CT analysis tool, in just five weeks.

With over €18M raised from top-tier investors, the startup refined its product, streamlined hospital integration (just 15 minutes to install), and cleared regulatory hurdles—paving the way for this acquisition.

Deep-tech, delivered. Congrats, icometrix.



Smart Ships, Smoother Seas? Europe Navigates Maritime Autonomy
