28DIGITAL Takes Home 3 SES Awards

Big win alert: 28DIGITAL [has been named](#) a **Startup Ecosystem Star 2025** by the ICC and Mind the Bridge — earning recognition in **three categories**: *Best-in-class Startup Programs*, *Top Talent & Research*, and *Pioneering Innovation Policy*. The awards [were presented](#) at ICC HQ in Paris alongside the OECD and European Commission, coinciding with Mind the Bridge's new report, "*The Calm Before the AI Storm*." The global snapshot shows a \$4.2T startup economy, nearly 98,000 scaleups, and a clear trend: AI is about to reshape innovation faster than any previous wave.

Why it matters:

The SES Awards spotlight the organisations shaping the next era of startup ecosystems — those investing in talent, collaboration, capital, and innovation-driven policy. Accepting the award, CEO Federico Menna put it simply: "This recognition validates our direction and the dedication of the entire 28DIGITAL ecosystem."

Joining Forces to Power San Marino's Innovation Future

Big move: A new strategic MoU unites **San Marino Innovation**, **GEA**, and **28DIGITAL** to accelerate the Republic's evolution into a dynamic innovation hub.

The agreement, signed by leaders from all three organisations, marks a major step for one of the world's smallest states aiming for outsized impact.

San Marino is emerging as a fertile ground for experimentation, startup growth, and digital transformation. Through this partnership, it gains access to proven innovation methodologies, global networks, and closer ties to Europe's leading tech ecosystems.

What's in the deal:

- Joint programmes connecting San Marino with top innovation hubs in Europe and the U.S.
- Co-designed initiatives to discover, validate, and scale new tech solutions.
- Challenge-driven calls engaging startups, corporates, universities, and research centres.
- Exploration of funding opportunities, including a potential San Marino-based deep-tech fund.
- Visibility and branding efforts to position San Marino as a credible innovation sandbox.

We're co-creating **Ecosystem as a Service**, a programme rooted in our ecosystem methodology. Its goal: help countries build resilient, interconnected innovation environments aligned with local priorities and anchored in strong governmental engagement.

The broader agenda:


- Long-term institutional capacity building

In Other News: Summer Schools, Smart Cities, Social Innovation & Digital Health

Summer School Programmes 2026 — Applications Open

28DIGITAL is expanding its Summer School offerings and is looking for universities and training providers to design new two-week programmes in emerging tech. The call is open to organisations across EU Member States and Horizon Europe—associated countries, with submissions due **19 January at 17:00 CET**. All details and requirements are available [on the open call homepage](#), and proposals must be submitted via the 28DIGITAL intranet.

Women in Digital Index Launched

The **WIDCON (Connecting Women in Digital)** project has released the **2025 Women in Digital Index**, a new data-driven benchmark tracking women's participation across Europe's digital pipeline — from STEM education to leadership. Launched in Brussels, the Index highlights persistent gaps in digital jobs and senior roles despite strong educational participation, and provides an evidence base to support more effective gender-equality policies across Europe.

□ ACCEND Scale-Up Accelerator — Deadline Extended

Smart city startups and SMEs now have until **23 December 2025** to join the ACCEND Scale-Up Accelerator, which offers tailored support, cross-border investor access, and a guided path to scale. The latest info day recording is available online, and [the application form](#) is live. Eligible companies must be headquartered in the EU or a Horizon Europe–associated country.

DiGi-SELL — Scaling Digital Capacity for Social Enterprises

The DiGi-SELL programme has extended its deadline to **9 January 2026**, supporting social enterprises and their support organisations with online learning, mentoring, matchmaking, and in-person exchanges. Participants can also receive up to **€2,000** for travel to programme events. Separate application forms remain available [for Social Enterprises](#) and [SESOs](#), with eligibility spanning Belgium, France, Greece, Sweden, Ukraine (for SEs) and the full EU/OCTs (for SESOs).

UNITE Open Call — €4M for the Future of Digital Health

UNITE is inviting innovators to submit solutions that advance remote care and health data interoperability, with up to **€1M** available per selected project. [The deadline is 15 January 2026](#), and applications must be submitted through the UNITE Cloud platform. Eligible applicants come from seven participating regions, including Zealand, Northern Netherlands, Central Macedonia, Lombardy, Extremadura, Scotland, and Romania. The UNITE project has also launched a [Call for External Experts](#) to evaluate the submitted proposals.
