

From Smart Sorting to Smarter Security: Al's Double Duty in Europe's Digital Future

Al has become a "force multiplier"— but for both sides.

- Offensively: All enables phishing attacks powered by hyper-personalized language models, adaptive malware that morphs to avoid detection, and deepfakes that blur reality.
- Defensively: It also powers automated detection, proactive threat hunting, smarter SOCs, and insider threat analysis via User Behavior Analytics.

But as Al helps both sides level up, the arms race intensifies—making **ethical deployment, explainability, and governance** more critical than ever. The message is clear: we need Al, but we also need to guide it.

In another article, Angelos Amditis takes us inside the world of robotic waste sorting systems—a fusion of AI, robotics, and smart manufacturing poised to accelerate the EU's circular economy goals. These systems use deep learning and

multispectral imaging to identify, sort, and trace complex waste streams with precision.

Deployed across sites in Spain and Italy, these smart systems are turning waste into high-value raw materials—helping Europe **reduce emissions**, **close resource loops**, **and digitally transform** industrial operations.
