Europe is buzzing with bold moves to shape its digital future. In this issue, we spotlight game-changing initiatives that boost strategic autonomy, fast-track innovation, and fuel inclusive growth across the continent.

We begin with an invitation to the Brussels launch of the **Makers & Shapers Report on Digital and Defence Innovation** for Europe's Strategic Autonomy. Organised by EIT Digital under the auspices of the Permanent Representation of Estonia to the EU, the event will convene leaders from policy, industry, and academia to explore the intersection of digital innovation and Europe's defence capabilities.

In our [Grow Digital Insights](#) feature, Asier Rufino Bengoechea, founder of Tecnalia Ventures, examines the central role of Research and Technology Organisations (RTOs) in powering Europe's deep tech ecosystem. His analysis outlines a roadmap for **translating scientific excellence into scalable industrial impact**, technological sovereignty, and resilient regional growth.

This month also brings a new opportunity for small and medium-sized enterprises. Deep Tech, Real Stakes: How Europe Can Lead the Next Industrial Wave

Science isn't the problem—scaling it is. In the latest *Grow Digital Insights*, Asier Rufino Bengoechea, founder of Tecnalia Ventures, dives into how Europe's Research and Technology Organisations (RTOs) are quietly powering a deep tech revolution. The goal? Turn cutting-edge science into scalable, industrial innovation.

Why it matters: Despite 95% of patents going unused and most SMEs underutilizing IP, Europe's RTOs—like Fraunhofer, CEA, and TECNALIA—have launched 4,000+ deep tech startups in the past decade. These aren't apps—they're tech solutions tackling real-world challenges in health, energy, mobility, and climate.

The challenge: Deep tech takes time. Teams often lack business skills, investors lack patience, and success is still measured in unicorns—not in long-term impact. Rufino calls for a shift toward “**Pegasus**” metrics: job creation, supply chain integration, and tech sovereignty.
